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Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting of Hatch Beauchamp Parish Council held on Wednesday 12th March 2025 at 7.00pm at the Village Hall

Public Forum

- A member of the public raised concerns about road signs being left in the village following completion of roadworks. It was advised to report these to Somerset Council for collection.
- The Chair of the village hall trustees advised that the notice board and map in agenda item 7 have been commissioned at a total cost of £2700. The play equipment total cost will be around £20k. A consultation will be done to ascertain the wishes of the community on the play equipment. The parish council has previously pledged monies towards this equipment.
- The Friends of Hatch Beauchamp School are holding an Easter Egg event of 29th March and a jumble sale on 27th April towards School funds. The school has recently won a "Rock Stars" maths award for top ranking in a 30 mile radius.
- Cllr Wakefield's latest Somerset Council report was circulated. The Somerset council tax was raised 7.5% with permission from central government, predominantly to meet the increasing cost of social care. Cllr Henley praised the proposed SEN facility at the school. The clerk raised the issue of improving the turning into Bickenhall Lane as raised by a parishioner, which Cllr Henley will take to Somerset Council Roads and Transport on our behalf.
